

## Instructions for Poster Presentation – IBM 2026

Thank you for participating in the **8th India Biodiversity Meet (IBM) 2026**. Please follow the guidelines below for your **poster presentation** to ensure a smooth and effective display of your research.

### Poster Format & Printing Requirements

- **Orientation:** Portrait
- **Size: Height: 39 inches, Width: 29 inches**
- **Print Quality:** Posters must be printed on **high-quality paper** with a **matte or satin finish** to reduce glare.
- **Printing Responsibility:** Presenters are responsible for printing and bringing their own posters to the conference.

### Poster Content & Design

- Ensure your poster is **clear, well-organized, and visually engaging**.
- Use **legible fonts** and maintain **adequate spacing** for easy readability.
- **Figures, graphs, and images** should be high resolution and well-labelled.
- Avoid overcrowding with text—use bullet points where possible.
- A **logical flow** of information should be maintained, from introduction to conclusion.

### Presentation Guidelines

- Presenters must stand by their posters during the designated session to engage with attendees and answer questions.
- Be prepared to provide a **brief, clear summary** of your research in 2–3 minutes.
- Ensure you can explain your methodology, results, and conclusions concisely.
- Engage with the audience and be open to discussions and feedback.

### Evaluation Criteria

Posters will be evaluated based on the following:

1. **Clarity and Organization of Content** – Logical structure and ease of understanding.
2. **Visual Appeal and Design** – Effective use of colour, images, and text formatting.
3. **Depth and Originality of Research** – The significance and innovation of the study.
4. **Presenter's Ability to Explain and Discuss the Poster** – Engagement with the audience and response to questions.
